Summons of Continuing Garnishment. This may be handwritten in black ink but must be legible

Attachment for Summons of Continuing Garnishment. This form is optional but can be useful to the garnishee/employer in confirming that the defendant is or is not their employee. The Court will NOT keep a record of this form. It is strictly used for assisting with locating and/or identifying the correct defendant by the garnishee/employer.

Notice to Defendant of Right Against Garnishment of Money, Including Wages, and Other Property

• The above two (2) forms are to be served upon the Defendant by both the Plaintiff and the garnishee/employer.

- Before a garnishment is issued on a CONSENT JUDGMENT, we must have a copy of a letter addressed to the defendant informing them that more than five (5) days have passed since the required payment because due and that the plaintiff now intends to enforce the collection of the judgment by any lawful means.
- This court charges \$1.00 per page for copies of Judgments or a FiFa that was entered by this Court.

The first envelope will be used to return a copy of the Affidavit of Continuing Garnishment and Summons of Continuing Garnishment to you once they have been entered into the Court and assigned a case number. The second envelope will be used to send a copy of the Sheriff's Entry of Service to you showing on what date the garnishee/employer was served.

You received this notice because money, including wages, and other property belonging to you have been garnished to pay a court judgment against you. HOWEVER, YOU MAY BE ABLE TO KEEP YOUR MONEY, INCLUDING WAGES, OR OTHER PROPERTY. **READ THIS NOTICE CAREFULLY.**

State and federal law protects some money, including wages, from garnishment even if it is in a bank. Some common exemptions are benefits from social security, supplemental security income, unemployment, workers' compensation, the Veterans' Administration, state pension, retirement funds, and disability income. This list of exemptions does not include all possible exemptions. A more detailed list of exemptions is available at the Clerk of Court's office located on the website for the Attorney General (https://law.georgia.gov/garnishment-exemption).

Garnishment of your earnings from your employment is limited to the lesser of 25 percent of your disposable earnings for a week or the amount by which your disposable earnings for a week exceed \$217.00. More than 25 percent of your disposable earnings may be taken from your earnings for the payment of child support or alimony or if a Chapter 13 bankruptcy allows a higher amount.

TO PROTECT YOUR MONEY, INCLUDING WAGES, AND OTHER PROPERTY FROM BEING GARNISHED, YOU MUST:

You may lose your right to claim an exemption if you do not file your claim form within 20 days after the Garnishee's Answer is filed or if you do not mail or deliver a copy of your completed claim form to the Plaintiff and the Garnishee at the addresses listed on this notice. The Court will schedule a hearing within ten days from when it receives your claim form. The Court will mail you the time and date of the hearing at the address that you provide on your claim form. This should be done within **3 business days** of the Garnishee being served with the Garnishment by the Sheriff's Deputy. (You should receive a copy of the Sheriff's Service in the mail showing you the day the Garnishee was served). If you would like a copy of your **AFFIDAVIT OF CONTINUING GARNISHMENT** and your **SUMMONS OF CONTINUING GARNISHMENT** e-mailed to you after they have been processed to ensure proper service upon the Defendant within due time, please include your e-mail on the Affidavit when filling it out.

Once you have sent the correct documents by certified mail and have received the green card back in the mail showing that the Defendant has been served (if you are sending the certified mail to the Defendant's work address, only the Defendant can sign for it) or once you have received the envelope back showing that the Defendant was not able to be served, make a copy of either and attach it to your completed **RETURN OF SERVICE UPON THE DEFENDANT** and return those documents to the Magistrate Court for filing.

If you have any questions regarding the requirements for filing a Continuing Garnishment in Magistrate Court, please contact the Clerk who processes them before mailing out your paperwork as to avoid your paperwork being returned to you.
